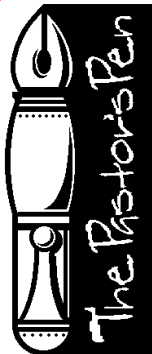


The Outreach

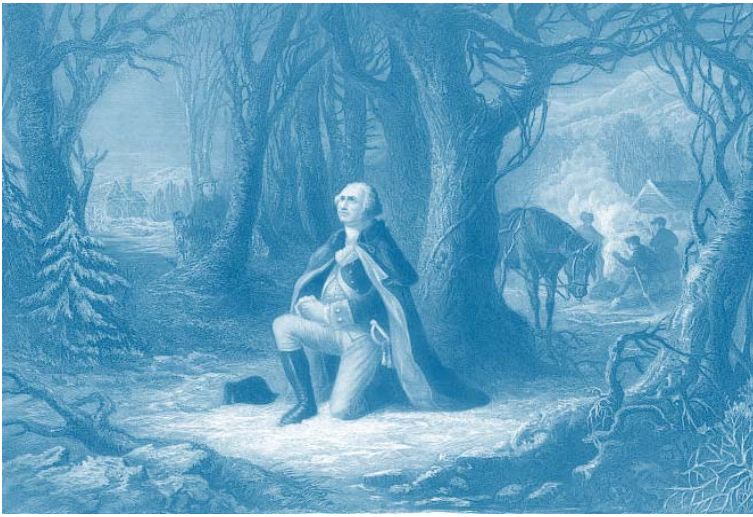

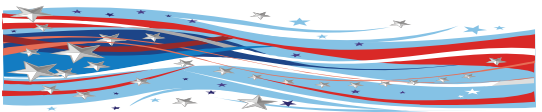
